Assembly Instructions and Guide

Thank you for choosing The Ramp Factory. Please read this guide carefully prior to use.

Intended Use

The shower stool is designed to be used as a mobility aid.

Unpacking

When unpacking the mobility aid please check you have all the required parts and fixings and contact The Ramp Factory if any items are missing. Please check the item for damage, if any damage is noted please contact the supplier immediately. Do not use a damaged item.

Assembly

To adjust the height, remove the 'E' clip from the extension leg and extend all legs evenly to the desired height ensuring you do not exceed the last punched hole of the extension leg. Once you have achieved the desired height; reinstall the 'E' clip, ensuring that it has passed through the extension leg and that it fits neatly and snugly around the outside leg.

Cleaning

Prior to cleaning the stool please remove all pin clips and the four extension legs with the ferrules fitted. Clean these items separately to the main frame.

Clean the plastic seat using a non-abrasive soft cloth with a mild detergent. Abrasive cleaners and/ or abrasive cleaning pads could seriously damage the seat beyond repair.

Using the Shower Stool Safely

- When moving always lift the shower stool by placing your hands on the tubular metal arms. •
- Do not allow children or unauthorised persons to play with the equipment or use without proper supervision.
- Do not rock back and forth or sideways when using the stool as this will cause excessive stress and possible damage and failure which may cause injury.
- Do not use the shower stool outside the home or on uneven surfaces (such as in the garden) as this will cause stress to the legs and possible damage which may cause injury.
- Do not place fingers or foreign objects into any of the exposed tubular sections as this can lead to serious injury.

Maintenance

Periodically check to ensure all components are present, correctly assembled and suitably tightened.

Warranty

The supplier provided a 1 year warranty against defects from the original purchase date. Please note the warranty will be void if the shower stool is used outside of the recommended guidance. No warranty is provided if the shower stool is used for purposes other than as a mobility aid. Returns
